#### SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Artwork must connect to Día de Los Muertos theme, imagery and/or related concepts. Please remember
  that our gallery is family friendly and school-age children will view the exhibits. We reserve the right to make
  curatorial decisions.
- Applicants can submit 1 4 artworks for the exhibition. Please send 1 MB jpeg, or pdf image files to <u>artsinfo@mattierhodes.org</u>. Include your Artist Statement/Bio with artwork submissions via email. Emails with links to websites will <u>not</u> be considered.
- Medium is open, and/or size can be exhibited larger works must be approved by Cultural Arts Coordinator.
- All artwork must be framed and/or ready to hang with appropriate hardware. Unprepared artwork will be removed from the show or the artist will be asked to correct the piece.
- Artwork must be original and signed by the Artist. Please have details prepared when artwork is delivered: Artist Name, Title of Artwork, Media, and Price (see attached)
- You will be asked to fill out a consignment form at time of delivery. Please note the sale price includes a
   40% commission to be given to Mattie Rhodes Center and a 60% profit to the artist.

Altar Proposal Deadline: September 4th

All Applicants must submit a proposal to create a traditional or contemporary altar in the exhibition. Applicants must also attend one of the Altar Making Discussion Workshops.

## Please include the following information in your proposal:

- 1. Name & Contact Information
- 2. Dimensions of the work (height, width, depth). Indoor altar spaces range from 2'x2' to 4'x4' of floor space, and up to 10' high on the wall. Outdoor spaces also available. We have some pedestals available only upon request on a first-come-first-serve basis. .
- 3. Materials which will be included in the work (paper, plastic, etc.)
- 4. Technical needs (extension cords, electrical plugs, etc.)
- 5. Title of Altar and/or Short Description (1 sentence)
- 6. Description (1 paragraph) explaining the idea/concept and/or person altar is intended for.
- 7. A visual image or sketch of the proposed piece or visual inspiration for your proposal.
- 8. Which Altar Making Workshop you will attend. (Fee is included in the donation price.)

### Submission deadlines for all proposals are by close of business Friday, September 4th, 6:00pm.

Jenny will be talking about the unique challenges of outdoor altar making as well as discussing traditional symbolism and processes surrounding creating a Day of the Dead altar. All are invited to attend regardless of participation in Mattie Rhodes' Day of the Dead exhibit. The discussion will be informal so feel free to bring your questions.
